1 Corinthians 15:14-20 (NLT)

14 And if Christ has not been raised, then all our preaching is useless, and your faith is useless. 15 And we apostles *would all be lying* about God—for we have said that God raised Christ from the grave. But that can't be true if there is no resurrection of the dead. 16 And if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised. 17 And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is useless and you are still guilty of your sins. 18 In that case, all who have died believing in Christ are lost! 19 And if our hope in Christ is only for this life, we are more to be pitied than anyone in the world.

20 *But in fact,* Christ has been raised from the dead.

2 Peter 1:16 (NIV)

16 We *did not follow cleverly invented stories* when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, *but we were eyewitnesses* of his majesty.

2 Timothy 3:16 (NLT)

16 All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to *teach* us what is true and to make us *realize* what is wrong in our lives. It *corrects* us when we are wrong and *teaches* us to do what is right.

Luke 1:1-4 (NIV)

1 Many have undertaken to draw up an account of the things that have been fulfilled among us, 2 just as they were handed down to us by those who from the first were eyewitnesses and servants of the word. 3 Therefore, *since I myself have carefully investigated everything* from the beginning, it seemed good also to me to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, 4 so that you may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.
